

This is a great resource for a whole study. If however you are wanting something to show within an hour or 30 minutes that talks about all aspects of the tabernacle, this isn't for you because it goes over something different each that has to do with the furnishings of the tabernacle and the priestly attire. I would highly recommend it for a whole study and think it a great resource. The pamphlet that goes with it is priceless and the study guide to answer questions and lead discussions is very thought provoking in helping people understand all of the meaning behind the placement, the color, the material used and the reason for each piece.

DVD Review: The TabernacleBy Shawn Barnard, MDivImportant Note: This review is for the 6-Session DVD and printable Leader Guide edition only. Therefore, other items in the Complete Kit For The Tabernacle DVD-based Bible Study were not available for review. Rose Publishing is currently a leader in publishing study books that are attractive, well laid out, and very useful; most of them are truly eye-candy. It is no different with The Tabernacle 6-Session DVD. I teach Tabernacle typology at a local Bible school; therefore, my expectations of Barnard's teaching may be a little higher than most. Barnard is a good communicator and the multimedia features added to the lectures are very helpful in aiding further understanding. Unfortunately, the audio in the lectures is uneven (the right channel is very low and unclear); still, the images used are beautiful; I just wish

they had used more of the relevant images throughout the presentations. Also, I'm not sure how I feel about some of the camera work; looking at the back of people's heads may seem interesting to some while unnerving others. Of course, most of the teaching was familiar to me; however, I did find one or two nuggets of gold in Barnard's teaching. As is common with any typological teaching, I think that sometimes Shawn went beyond the Biblical evidence in some applications (e.g. the Trinity in the Tabernacle?), but overall he tries to stay grounded in Scripture. Further, I could not agree with his statement that, "Everything in Scripture points to and finds its fulfillment in Jesus Christ." Most current scholars of Hermeneutics would not agree with that position. I think most of us can think of Old Testament passages that cannot point to Jesus in a typological fashion (descriptions of geographical locations, numbers, genealogies, descriptions of sinful behavior, etc.). That is not to say that Jesus is not present in the Old Testament; He certainly is present in every division of the Hebrew Bible! (See John 5:39: Luke 24:27, 44-45.) All the video sessions come in one DVD; the second DVD contains marketing materials for the class and also a 96 page Leader's Guide that is very nicely done and could be useful in teaching a class on the subject at your local church as it contains suggestions on group activities. Of course, the student's would have to avail themselves of the Student's Notes with fill-in-the-blanks elsewhere since they are not included in this package (see the Complete Kit for the Tabernacle from Rose Publishing that does include those). Viewing all sessions takes about three hours; hardly enough time to give an adequate overview of the richness of the typology found in the descriptions of the Tabernacle plan and function. This need not be seen as a negative comment; I just wish Barnard took his time explaining each lesson in more detail; he seems to have more to share than he had time to. Maybe Rose Publishing will produce a more complete course on the subject (one also has to keep in mind that Rose has a book and other materials on the subject that can complement the DVD series). Having said that, I think the DVD study is an excellent primer on Tabernacle typology for the average church member. Get this resource. Highly recommended Tabernacle DVD seriesPlease note: This is a review of the "6-Session DVD Study with printable leader guide, fliers & posters (PDF)" not the "Complete Kit" edition.My recommendation: I highly recommend this 6-session DVD series for individual or group study, with a disclaimer that the series is presented by a Protestant, and Catholics will note a few points that do not agree with Catholic Doctrine. The included DVD with PDF files for printable leader guide and

promotional materials was thorough and easily adaptable for many uses. Why the Tabernacle study? I facilitate a Salvation History Class and found the Rose Publishing visual aids were a fantastic way to engage in somewhat dry historical topics. I found myself being drawn to know more about the Tabernacle, just what was it, and maybe there was a story there to enhance my knowledge of Biblical history as well as my own worship. The topics were well covered and with depth to inspire me to review certain topics again. Highlights: I enjoyed the progressive tour of the Tabernacle which began with an explanation of how the 12 tribes of Israel were set up around the Tabernacle with the Levites closest to the Tabernacle. I found the series very easy to follow. I particularly enjoyed Barnard's presentation of theology of the Tabernacle in relation to specific scriptures and in relation to how we worship today. I intend to use the list of scriptures related to topics in the PDF leader guide. I had a few ah-ha moments, such as the high priest sprinkling blood on the Mercy Seat made of acacia wood on the Day of Atonement foreshadowing Christ's blood on the cross. Negatives/Distractions: (for which I will deduct one star from total of five stars)1) Preacher-type presentation in front of a large stained-glass background. The audience, as seen from behind, were sitting in the dark and never seemed to move or make a sound. Very odd. I would have preferred to see less of Barnard gesticulating and more shots of religious artwork or illustrations depicting the topic at hand.2) I am not in full agreement with Barnard's repeated "truth" that "Everything in scripture points to and finds fulfillment in Jesus Christ." My problem is with the "everything." I suspect his meaning is that the whole of scripture is a story of salvation.3) Barnard's typology, in my opinion, was excessive to the point of being a distraction. In this case, less is more. This DVD series is a thorough but not overwhelming introduction to study of the Tabernacle which I suggest will fulfill the needs of your individual or group study as well as deepen your faith.
