


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33 Day Trips From London

The book deals with the day trip possibilities in the briefest of descriptions. One might hope for more "pearls", insider hints about the highlights, limits, access and the like. Whereas there may be several different London train stations from which some of the sites may be accessed. the book tends not to explore these options which would certainly present advantages to those who do not know train travel options in the UK. It might be useful to understand which train trips would be facilitated with the use of various passes, local (Oyster) and international (Britrail). Also, a little more detail about the distance from the remote station to the major sites to be visited might be useful. When one provides 33 day trips, why not explore which of these could easily be visited from the same train line in one day if willing to abbreviate their visits? Admittedly, the poor quality of the print has affected my assessment. The binding is far too close to the margin of print, the font is too small and the paper is sub optimal.

Don't let the bargain basement price fool you into thinking this is not worth buying. It is excellent! My other guidebooks (Frommers, etc.) have 3 or 4 daytrips. This has, as you can tell from the title, 33. There are a few that are geared for families who live in London, and would not be top choices for tourists with a limited amount of time to spend in the area. Most trips are great for Londonders and tourists. The author tells you everything you need to know: how to get, there including the best method; all the sights, including prices and special offers; her opinions on which are the must-sees; which sights at each location are best for children; ideas on places to eat, and probably stuff I forgot.

This easy to read book had great suggestions for where to visit. I didn't read it play-by-play like a Rick Steves guide, but I think that's ok. Reading it at home months before as I planned out my trip was very helpful. The forest was wonderful by the way and somewhat new. It's not as touristy!
