

This is a great kayaking guide for Texas rivers! K just wish they would come up with an updated one since this one was published way back in 2000.

This has been the only book I've found that is a good canoeing guide for the rivers in TX (it includes AR and OK too). Each description is about 1 page in length and has the following sections: physical location, general comments, water quality, water flow, preferred seasons, hazards, put in, take out, camping, canoe rental & shuttle service, distinguishing features, fishing, maps and where to get river flow information. Each river also has a map that shows mileage, creeks, roads, etc. Overall, it was a good purchase but a little pricey.

Looking for new river trip or want to read up on your local section in Texas, Oklahoma, or Arkansas. We'll then this is the book for you. Worth the price, it's a gem. Has every thing you need to know about all the rivers in these three states.
