

Although a real snoozer of a book I appreciate it's attempt to reclaim their "gay" heritage. It's just that in 1988 there wasn't that much to reclaim so they made mountains out of molehills. The early chapters quote from ethnographic studies and is dry and difficult to get through since many of the tribes described have similar traditions, The book comes to life late in the reading when it switches over to the voices of contemporary gay Native Americans and the poems and stories they are writing from their legacy of Native American beliefs and traditions.

The book has been a useful and valuable tool for my class English 710, Gender and Sexuality in American Indian Literature. Informative and enlightening. Members of numerous tribes are heard from. Resource section allows for further study.
