While not 100% accurate in some songs, but it is the closest to accurate a bass tabs I have seen, so I highly recommend this. The Abbey Road bass series is excellent as well. I now hope that Hal Leonard will come out with the other Beatles Albums bass series as good as these have turned out to be.

I am very happy with this, but the bass line is a bit simplified.

I bought this for my son to learn bass guitar, he's a real Beatles freak. Since I play bass, I figured I could help teach him tablature, and that was fine, as far as it went. But he got a 6-string and Dad became the bass player. Well, it wasn't long before we discovered that the chord symbols weren't quite right. With the help of "The Beatles Complete Scores" (also by Hal Leonard, also tabbed) he's now sounding just like John and George. This is a good starter book, but you'll probably notice some of the songs don't quite sound exactly right. It's plenty good enough for living-room concerts, though. And if you only use it for the bass parts, it will get you by.

I play the bass and love Paul and the Beatles! It was actually a gift but couldn't help myself and gave it a quick read through and preview. McCartney is the man, really good transcription of parts! Can't beat it!

It's a very good songbook. I recommend it!

My boyfriend loves the Beatles, and is currently learning how to play the Bass, So I thought it was only fitting he learned the songs he loves, and with this book he is able to. Very easy to read, and understand. Love the product
