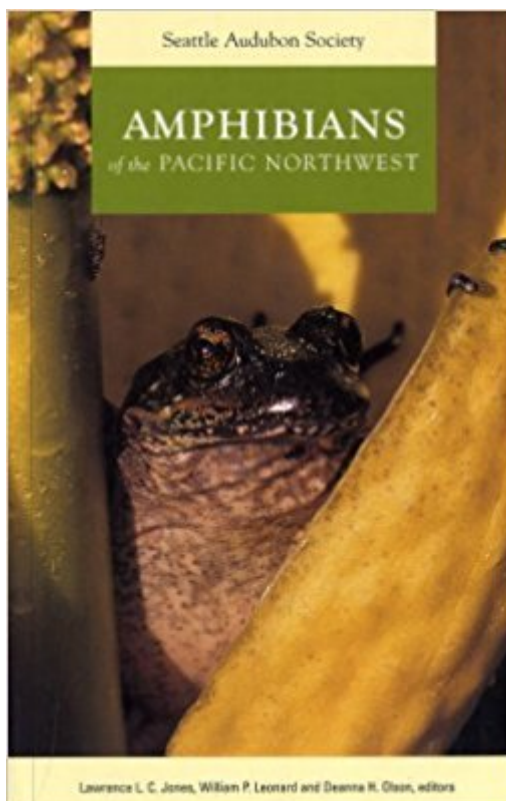

If you live in Washington, Oregon, BC, or Northern California, this is the only book you need on amphibians. It is well written and organized with excellent photos. Each species has several pages of description on their life history, reproduction, habitat, and situation. It provides everything you need to identify them and, in my mind more importantly, understand them. I was especially impressed with the inclusion of photos of the frogs and salamanders in their nymph and paedemorph stages. This was a nice bonus and clearly was not easy to obtain. This text is well written for a broad audience and would be helpful for middle school students up to and including scientists working with ecology or local ecosystems. A must have for the forest library.
