

I really like Jonathan Moeller's stories. They are well thought out and well told for the most part. Demon Souled was arguably very well written and proofread. The story was in depth and without a doubt very well thought out. I have read the entire series before posting a review so I could review the entire series instead of just one book. I will copy and paste to the other versions as well. As stated Demon Souled was well written and proofread. HOWEVER, this is the only one I can say that about. Overall I read it all and was able to delve into the story, however the poor proofreading and grammar in some situations caused an interruption in the story. As I was reading I would stop confused and then realize he mistyped something or used the wrong word as a typo. Something proofreading his work would have corrected. His repetition often caused me to skip chapters at a time for details I got tired of reading again and again, just to get back to the story. It felt like filler material. I still give him four stars simply because if you get around those negative aspects of the books. The story is unique and compelling. Jonathan himself seems to be a great individual as he answered questions from me as I was reading the books. I pride myself on honesty and it actually hurts me to write anything negative about his stories as I do enjoy them.

I couldn't decide whether to buy book 4 or not, but went ahead and did it anyway. I tell you, readers, I am all Malrag'd and Ograg'd out. Book 4 is starting to bleed into his Frostborn series - the Urdmoloch have shown up, as has the forest where the Dark Highelves (the Traveler) have made their dominion. Mazael is once again succumbing to his demon nature. You would think he could not wield his sword, Lion, if he were truly demonsouled. You'd think the sword would make him kill himself......And Lucan. I'm tired of Lucan. Doing really bad things in the name of doing good (he thinks). The books so far have had positive resolutions, but the evil and the death that precede the

resolution are all the same. Vicious, violent and ultimately boring, as they have happened just the same way in all the preceding books. And I agree with one reviewer who said the spelling is bad. Didn't anyone proofread these books?? Not so much this book - but the first one - OY!!

Mazael and his band are still together. Just when it seems that they can beat the malag hordes and the rogue magician, Lucan's tortured body is kidnapped. Another foe has arisen and Mazael's past has come flooding back to haunt him and possibly destroy the world.

Jonathan Moeller has created an entertaining series. I like the fact that Manzel has increased his inner circle of friends, a few supporting characters have more detail in this installment, which helps the series. I am hoping the next books expand to different types of adventures, although well written and described, some items are starting to get stale for me. It's not time to give up yet, the next book is on my radar.

I like the whole Demonsouled series. As with the Frostborn series he tends to repeat things over and over and over again. Very annoying but after a while you just end up skimming through the repetitions.
