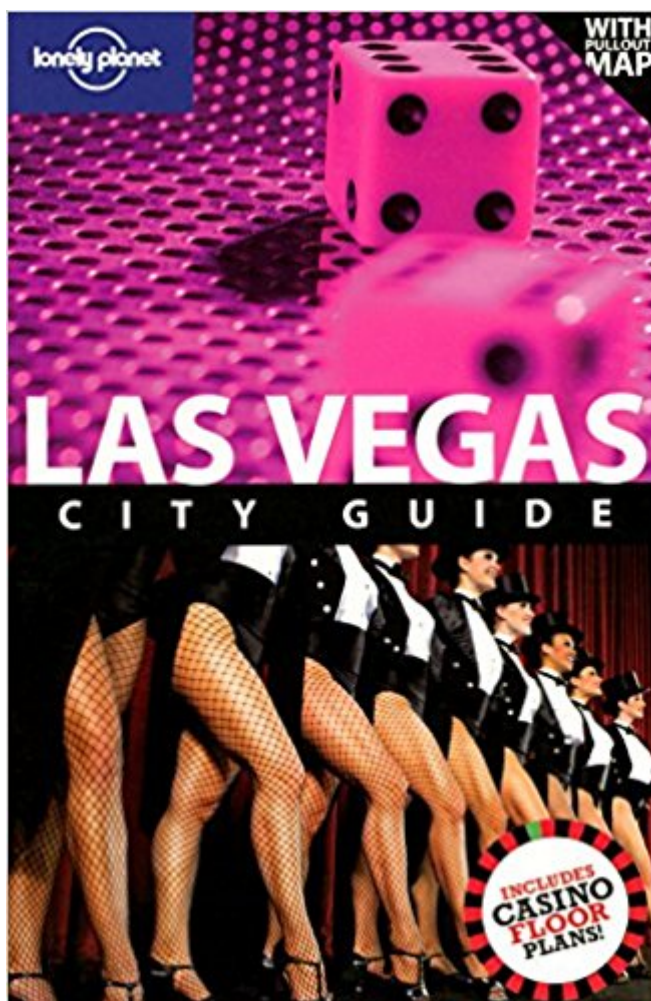

I was going to Vegas on business. I had not been there in several years and wanted a good guidebook with recommendations on restaurants and shows. I ordered two books based on customer reviews on the web site. This book had two 5-star rave reviews. I did not notice that the reviews were actually for a different book and from 2007.
