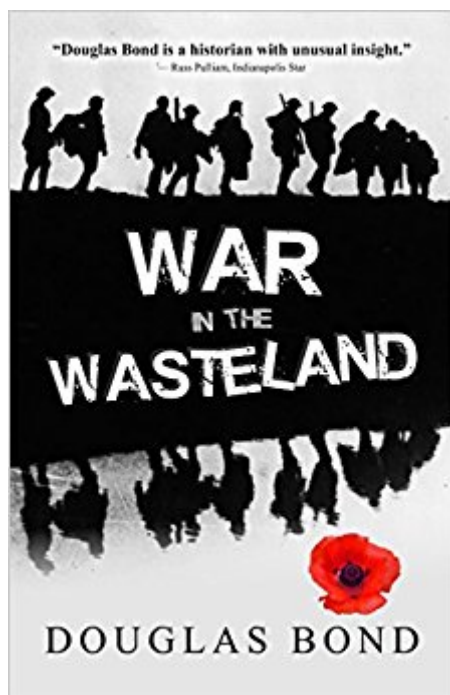

I don't know if Mr. Bond has ever been in war. Certainly no one today knows first hand what the trenches were like in WWI. However, Douglas Bond did an admirable job bringing it to life (Or rather, death, would be the more appropriate word) and incorporating some of the real life facts and character from the life of C.S. Lewis to show how this time helped change him from bitter professing atheist to one of the greatest Christian apologists of all time.
