

Minnie sets out for Montana to be a stranger's bride, but is reluctant to go through with it. On the train from lowa Minnie meets Scarlett, a woman running from the cruel owner of a saloon who thinks he owns her because she works for him. Scarlett listens to Minnie sobbing story about not wanting to marry a stranger. When the train arrives in Bryan, Montana, both women get off the train, but Minnie disappears and Scarlett is standing there when the stagecoach driver mistakes her for Minnie. Not having anywhere to go, and trying to outrun Mr. Grogan, Scarlett decides to step into Minnie's role as a mail order bride for Joe Baker. After all, she won't really have to marry him, just hide out for awhile until she can take off for San Francisco. Sparks fly when Joe and Scarlett aka Minnie get to know each other. Rustlers show up a couple of times, Scarlett confesses who she really is, and Joe forgives her and falls in love and promises to never let her go. Peace reigns until Minnie shows up wanting Joe to marry her as she has run out of money and has no place to go. Will Joe honor his promise to Minnie even though she broke the promise first? Will Scarlett end up along again and on the run? Read this fine story in the Cutter's Creek series to find out what happens.
