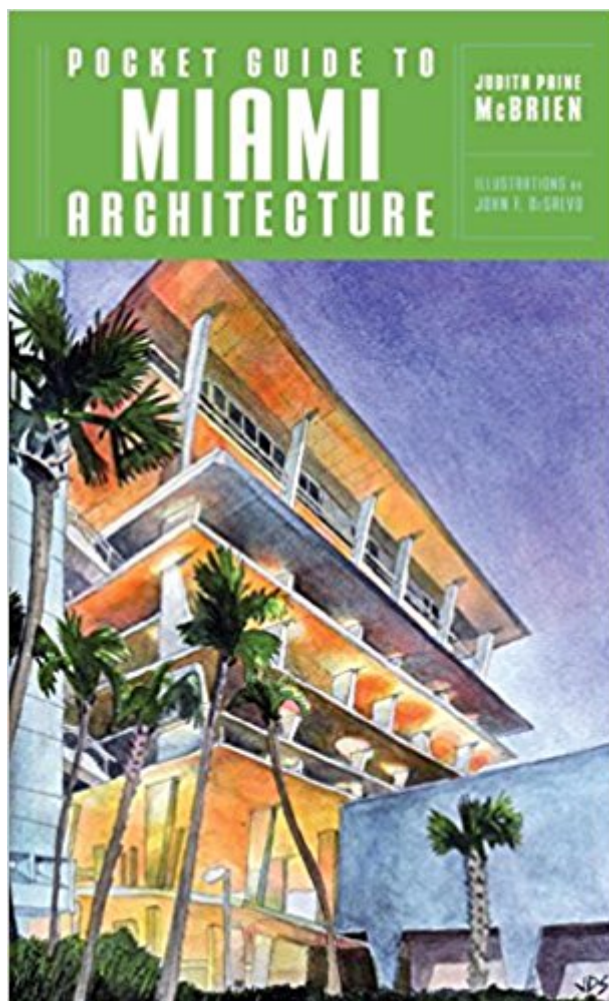

It's not an AIA (American Institute of Architects) guide to architecture, but it is nicely produced. The line art drawings of each property are incredible. They make me wonder if they're tracings of photos of the actual buildings. Nonetheless, the guide covers the essentials of what a tourist would/should note while visiting. Makes a nice keepsake following a trip to the area.

Whether as a tourist, like ourselves, or a local, using this guidebook will give you information and insights about Miami's historic and continually evolving skyline. Good for architecture geeks and those just wishing to know more information about the buildings around them.

This guide to Miami is nice, but it has black and white drawings of the buildings instead of photographs. It's ok and give a good amount of information about the different styles.
