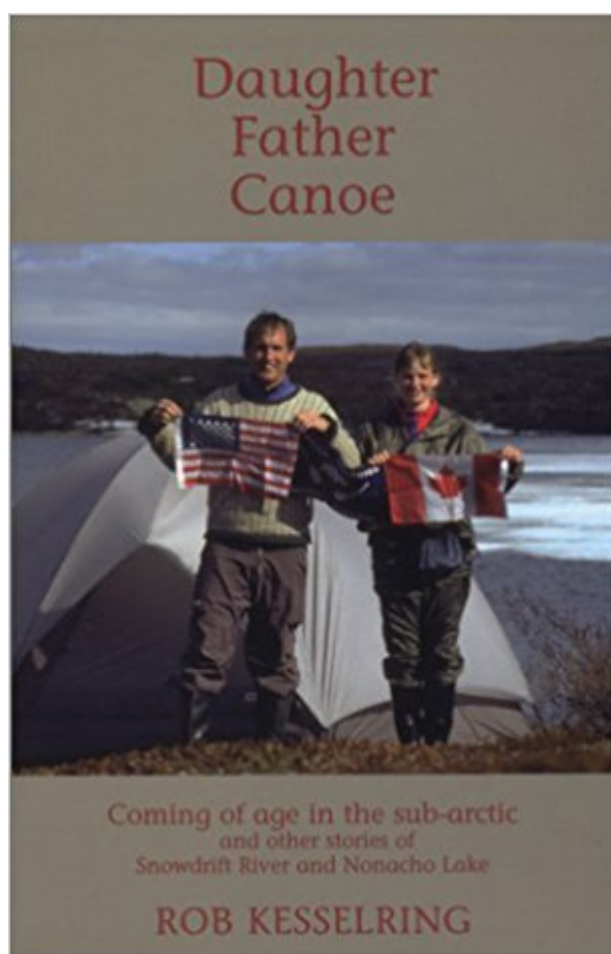

In his 20s, Rob lived in the Northwest Territories of Canada, including one year more than 200 miles from his nearest neighbor. Ten years later, he returned to this rugged land with his 14-year-old daughter, Lara, to take a 27-day canoe trip through the Canadian wilderness.

I really enjoyed this book. The stories really resonated with me. I live in canoe country and travel into the wilderness with my 13 year old daughter frequently. I am also a bush pilot and lover of the north country. I have been reading Rob's stories and advice on bush craft for a number of years. My

daughter gave me this book and it was a real treat.

I understand that it may be desirable and probably necessary to exaggerate here and there to make the story more interesting, but some claims were a little hard to believe.
