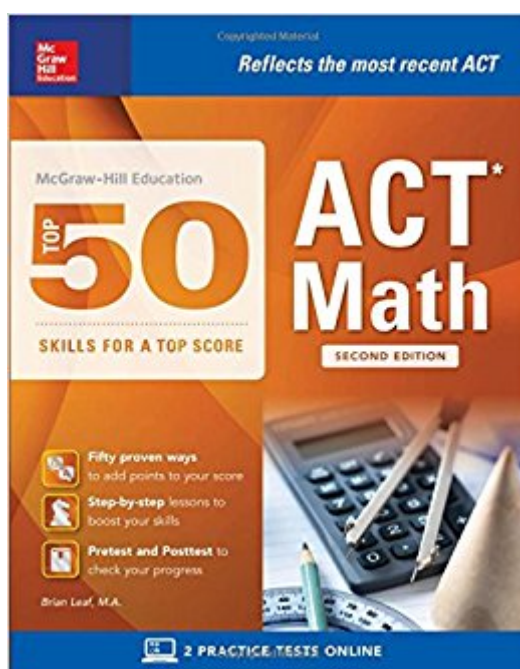

This book is great! It makes it very easy to pinpoint what math concepts you need to study and master without extra information. Each concept involves a math mantra that concisely states what information you need to know for your ACT test. With that said, the book has little in-depth explanation. I'm taking calculus, so it wasn't difficult for me to review these concepts that I already knew, I just needed to refresh and strengthen those skills. But, for someone who isn't as strong in math or as advanced in math, this book would be more helpful alongside a teacher or parent to completely teach the concepts. The book has a lot of humor and understands the stress of the ACT test. It also includes information for meditation and relaxation before your test. I will say if I could change anything, I would change the number of questions in the pretest and posttest to 60 questions instead of 50, as the actual ACT test consists of 60 questions. I would highly recommend this book for anyone who can self-study and already has a decent background in math.

My son and I loved the way Brian Leaf put this book together. I think out of all the Review books out there Brian has really found a recipe that makes it interesting and engaging. I would buy any of the review books this guy puts out there. They are easy to understand and provides detailed explanation of how to do a problem.
