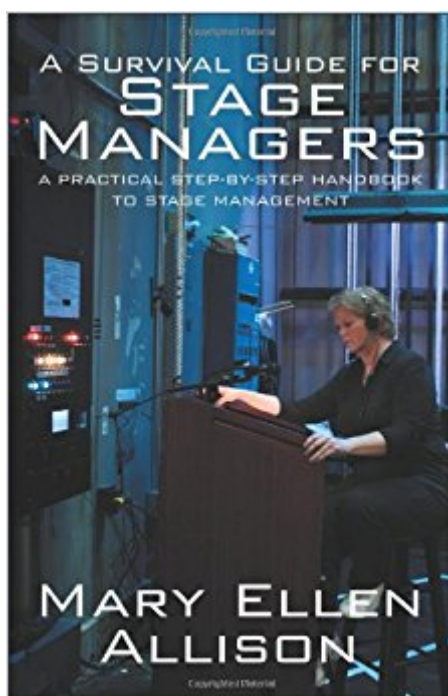

Then, it got a little technical for me. However, I gave it to my daughter and she loves it. It confirmed some things for her that she had questions about and gave her some good insight. It is easy to read. It is a good book for stage managers at the early part of their career, or for family members of stage managers to understand the profession.
