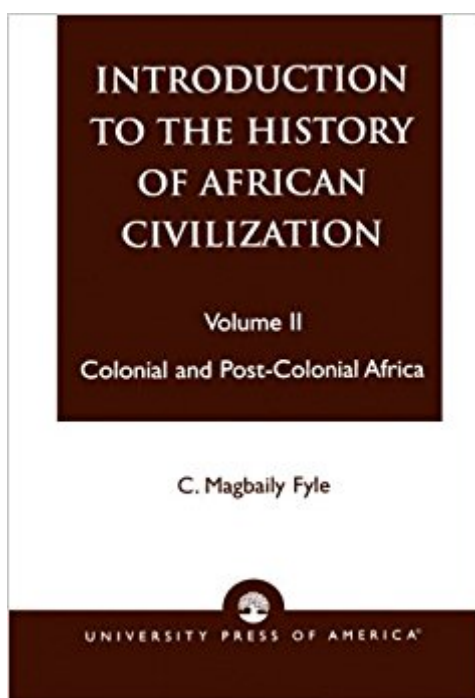

Synopsis

This second volume of Introduction to the History of African Civilization examines Africa's history in the controversial twentieth century. It focuses on the methods of domination that were employed by colonial powers, and the new methods of domination, which were invented and employed by Western nations in the post-colonial period. While the book covers the partition of Africa, the nature and impact of colonial rule and the post-colonial situation in Africa, it is not simply a history text, for it investigates matters usually avoided in historical studies of twentieth century Africa, including the psychological impact of colonialism on the emergent middle class. Also explored is the impact of the IMF and World Bank on African economies in the post-colonial era.

It is hard to find literature that encompasses African history as a whole from a political, economic and cultural point of view. This book does that and it has helped me learn quite a bit. That being said, I think that throughout the book it is very biased. The author is a man from Sierra Leone who has a very hard time being objective when analysing the roots of African troubles today. Although he explains in a very eye-opening way the atrocities committed by the Belgians, or the treachery and violence by the British and French, he associates 100% of Africa's problems with the White Man, no exception whatsoever. Needless to say that is not true, Idi Amin Dada, Robert Mugabe and more recently Joseph Kony are excellent examples. Not one African was given any blame whatsoever for the state Africa is in. Just to give you an example, the RUF of the author's home country Sierra Leone was simply described as "rebels". I invite readers to look up the RUF if they are not familiar with it. So, use caution when reading this book as it is definitely not impartial.
