

Acharya S's books continue to move into the category of "Classics" that stand the test of time and endure through the ages. No book shelf on the history of religion would be complete without "The Christ Conspiracy" and "Suns of God."

If I had nothing else to say here, I could definitely say that Acharya S has done her homework and has carefully documented her sources, showing the depth of her research and scholarship. This is a long book, and quite detailed, but it is not difficult to read or understand. No matter what one's religious views are, Suns of God provides information that ought to be of interest even if only for its historical value. I believe it offers more, however, as it provides a new way of looking at old stories that prompts a desire to dig even deeper; and having read this book by Acharya S, I am eager to read more from her.

The genius of this book is the way it takes the macro view of the three major historical religions. Rarely do we find such a clear focus from such a wide angle point of view. By zooming out on the three religions, and I mean zooming all the way out into outer space and looking back at them from a space satellite point of view as it were, the author discovers similarities that are not apparent in a close up examination. As it turns out viewing these religions from such a far distance, from the perspective of our sun looking down on planet earth, turns out to be a natural and organic viewpoint to take. It is, in fact, the proper angle from which to view the origins of these religions, for only from this macro perspective do we discover what they share in common. We discover the roots of the three major religions are grounded, earthed, and birthed in solar mythology. This is the common baptism in light shared by each of the three major religions. Such a revelation becomes apparent only by taking the macro view. That is the genius of the author's approach in this book. This book is not light reading but it is illuminating for those who wish to view the three major religions from a cosmic perspective.
