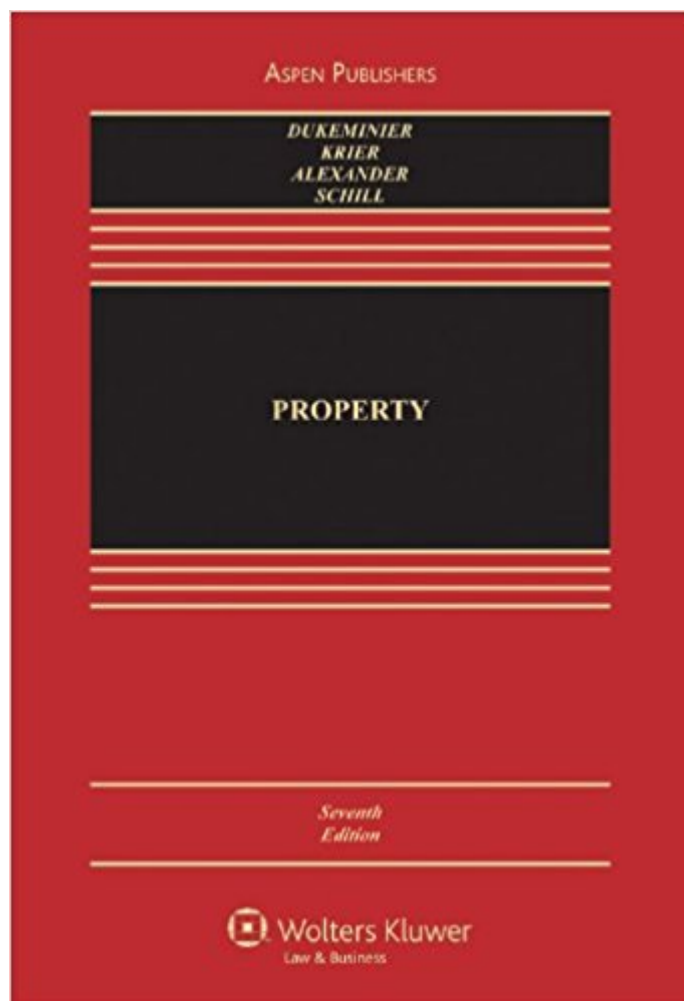

This is my favorite text book this semester. The book does an amazing job at explaining hard concepts with notes before just jumping right into the cases. It also provides problems and answers which are a must for property!

This book is FULL of crazy 1L highlighting and notes that are so unnecessary to the material. Not worth the money. The pages are nearly illegible.

Typical legal academics at work here. They include some poorly edited cases; some esoteric law articles; the answers to practice questions either pose another question for the student or direct the student to read a case that is not included in the book. Instead of helping navigate the incredibly difficult course of property, this book merely creates more work for you, while lining the pockets of some elitist legal scholars who did nothing but copy and paste a bunch of work already written for them.
