

I first discovered For 91 Days through their blog. I was preparing for a move to Buenos Aires and came across what I found to be one of the most valuable resources around. Their writing was

entertaining and extremely helpful. It translates beautifully into this book. Instead of the dry, tiny paragraph recommendations you'll find from guide books, this one really dives in to the what's special about each location. The entries are succinct enough to read quickly, but with just enough detail to get an understanding of what you'll appreciate about each place. After a year in Buenos Aires, I can say that their recommendations are spot on. They explore a variety of neighborhoods and give a great overview for what's special in each in terms of food, attractions or even the neighborhood itself. It's like they've been living here for much longer than their 90 day period. My husband and I still reach for it to plan our next outing or restaurant meal. Fantastic read and highly recommended!

I'm officially hooked on the For 91 Days series and will be checking out whether they have published titles in future cities I visit. The books are entertaining and well written. The authors travel to a wide range of off the tourist track places and provide both practical and personal commentary. There's links to photos, etc. that help to enhance the book and give you more ideas on where to go in BA.

I read this book in preparation for our upcoming trip to Buenos Aires and got so many fantastic ideas for things to do, sights to see and restaurants to check out. The authors spent three months in Buenos Aires and you can see that they went well beyond the 'tourist trail'. Of course the main sights and museums are covered, but I found quite a few museums and galleries that I had not seen in any guidebook and I can't wait to try some of the places to eat they recommend. This book is especially helpful if you plan to spend a longer time in the city and have more time to explore Buenos Aires than just visiting the main sights. I loved the personal anecdotes in the book and felt like I got plenty of tips and personal recommendations in this book that I had not read anywhere else.

We're planning a trip to Argentina later this year and have been trying to find a book that went beyond the standard "guide book" lists. And we found it with this book. A personal and at times quirky accounting of the authors favorite things to do and eat and see while they lived in Buenos Aires for 3 months. We've previously read their 91 days in Savannah book which we loved. As in that book and on the author's blog, the photography is superb and reveals the City in a way standard guidebooks do not. I like that the book is a kindle edition where on my Kindle Fire I can easily click on links to their blog and to websites for restaurants and museums. Very well done.
