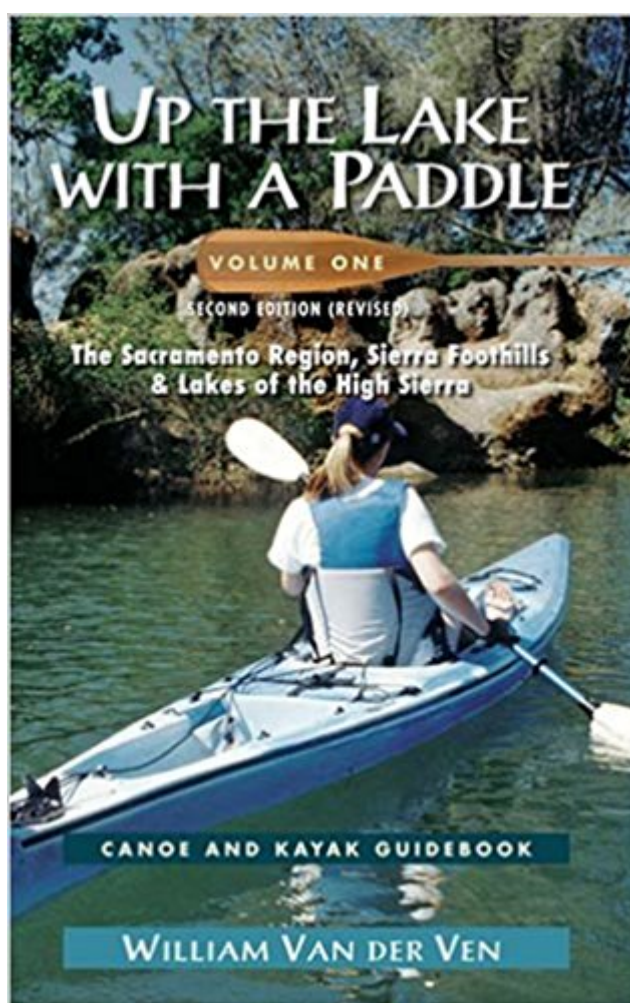

Having completed his Air Force commitment with a tour in Vietnam as an Aerial Reconnaissance Photographer, he graduated from San Francisco State University with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Anthropology (Archaeology) followed by a Teaching Credential. Bill worked as a caretaker at the Calico Early Man Site under the tutelage of Ruth DeEtte Simpson.
