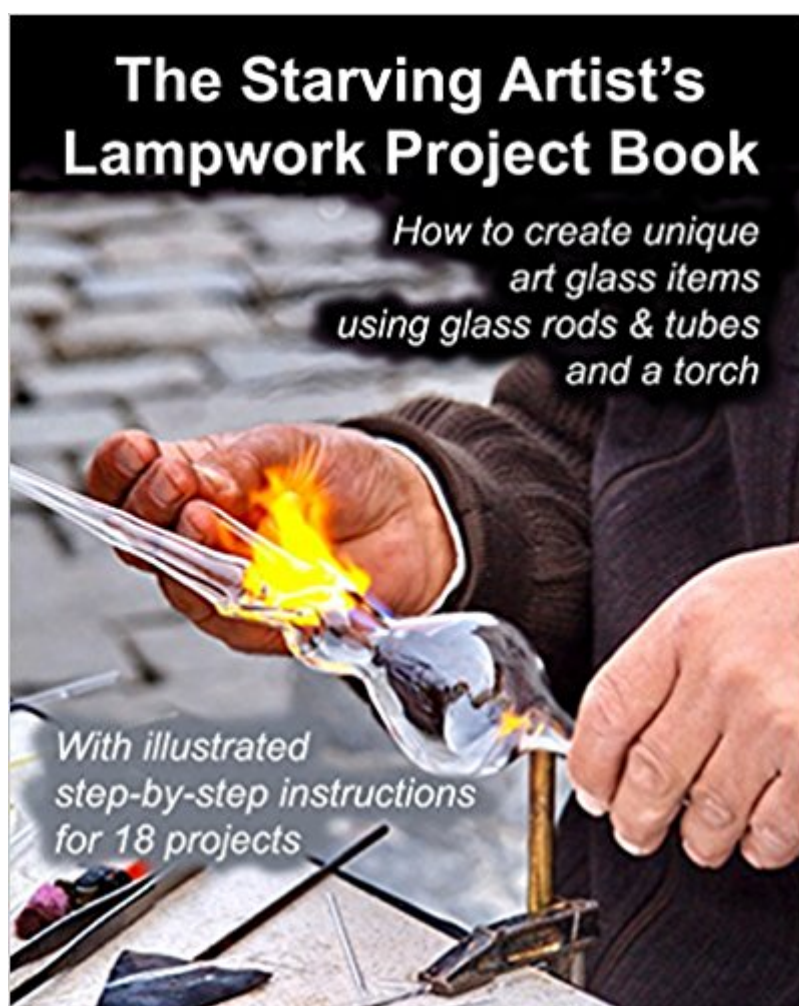

Also known as scientific glassblowing, lampwork is a method of manipulating glass rods and tubes in a gas torch flame to construct a variety of practical and artistic items. No furnace is required, and the necessary tools and materials can be readily obtained at reasonable cost.

I can't recommend this book. As a lampworker of many years, and a teacher - there is nothing in this book that you could not get out of a quick google search. While it is intended to be a historical re-print and of interest to those with an interest in history, either of lampworking or veteran rehabilitation - it is just not worth it. Give this one a pass.

I would have liked a little more in depth illustrations , but still a lot of help just starting out.

I'm a beginner lampworker myself, and with no training, I knew everything the book taught after watching one or two youtube videos. The new stuff in the book wasn't helpful at all. They give you a "here's a thing, now you make it" with no details on how to overcome the obstacles or listing any potential setbacks you'll run into while making the thing. I used the "Look Inside" feature before

purchasing and it didn't illuminate this deficiency or I wouldn't have purchased in the first place.
