

Last year, I attended the 10-week study based on this book at a nearby church and felt so inspired that I decided to conduct it at my home church. The leader's kit contained a hard-copy of the book, but since I do most of my reading on my iPad, I purchased the Kindle edition. The book contains numerous anecdotes and insights as to what manhood means. The book moves through childhood and adolescence and discusses how to become a man, then move on to mentorship, and finally achieve the status of a patriarch. The only mild criticism I have is that each section starts with a riveting story of courage in action, but the story does not necessarily tie in well with the main topic of the section. The neat part of reading the Kindle edition is the ability to click on the links and go to the references and additional resources.
