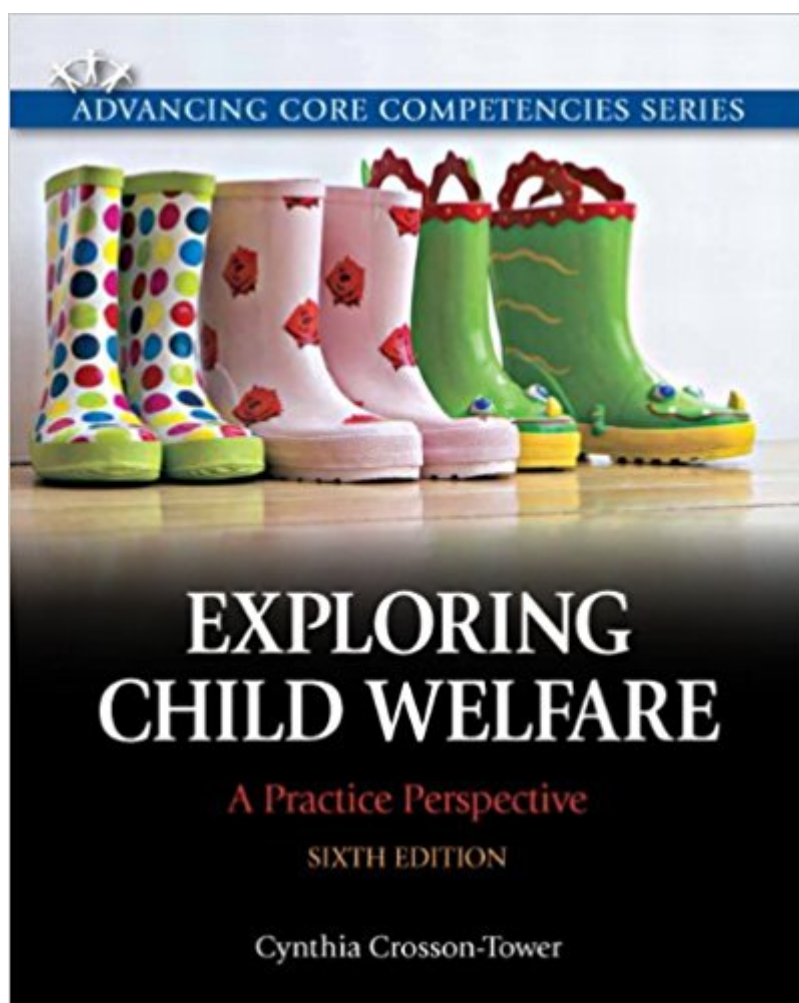

Are you a college student looking for an addition to your room that could also benefit your education? Well I have the one for you! I'm sorry to say this about a book, but this book makes me fall asleep. The facts and numbers are great (though I haven't verified them personally) but the rest of it is quite boring and repetitive. I'm forced to read it for a children's services social work class at NYU. But if you have a choice, buy something more stimulating.

Do NOT buy the combo pack; Pearson scammed my instructor by telling her that you needed to buy the book and the MySearchLab Access Card, but the access card provides you with an electronic copy of the book. That makes buying the combo pack pointless and false advertising. If you want the book, just pay for the Standalone Access Card. You'll be saving over \$100 by doing so.

Usual Textbook MINUS the bold or highlighted text normally seen in a book! Works well for both, upperclassman and mature individuals, as I do not recommend for those who find it hard to pay attention or stay focused. (Kindle edition permits individual to highlight what s/he thinks is important/beneficial)
