

As they sat overlooking the shores of Lake Michigan, her grandmother shared memories of her childhood on a Michigan farm. These treasured family stories became the basis for the Grandma \hat{A} ¢ \hat{a} $\neg \hat{a}$,¢s Attic series.

I cannot say enough about this book series. If you want humorous stories with a moral message

behind them, then you will not be disappointed with this series. The grandma who shared these stories with her granddaughter was a child in the late 1800's, which is the same childhood timeframe as Laura Ingalls Wilder. I think these books will always be a favorite of ours. They have our whole family laughing at times, to the point of tears. This series is a must for all families with girls, but I know even boys will love hearing about the mischief this grandma got into as a kid.

I hadn't realized that the main character was a girl and was concerned that my 9 yr old son might not like them for this reason. However, he loves them! He is learning character lessons and enjoying it at the same time. He finds them funny and can't wait to share them with me after he has read them. They would have made great read alouds but he is enjoying reading them on his own. He is even choosing them for fun!

My daughter got this whole series of books when she turned 8. She can easily read them herself and has often referred to several of the lessons that the author learned in these stories. Each chapter is a different story, so you can pick it up and read whatever you have time for. These would also be great to read to younger children. The stories are from "the olden days" and are good, wholesome stories that we often laugh at and usually learn a lesson from. Highly recommended.

This books series is soo good that I want to thank Arleta for writing it. This has been such entertainment for me and my sons. As a daddy reading with all the characters and seeing how much my sons enjoyed these books (twice for each book) it's been the best book series we've ever read. This is a great set of books for girls. These are books of stories rather than chapter books, so you can enjoy each story on its own. The situations that the little pioneer girl, Mabel, gets into (often with her best friend, Sarah Jane) are funny, but realistic and they usually have a lesson as well. The illustrations are updated from the ones I remembered, and are adorable.
