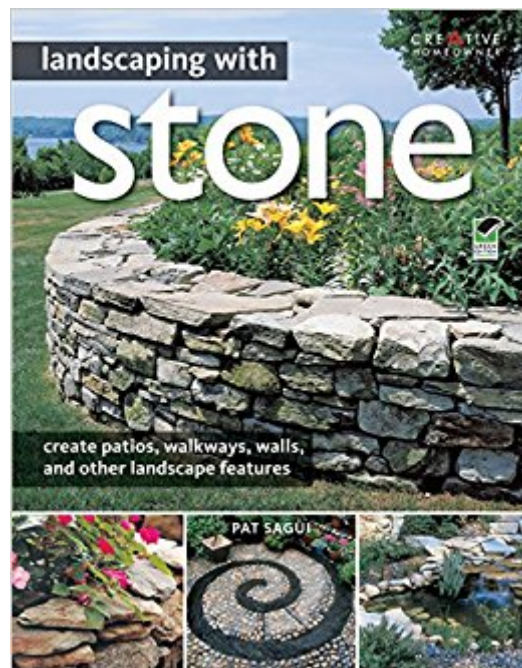

None of these books explain exactly how to build stone patios and walls and pathways by yourself but this one has more detail than most out there.
