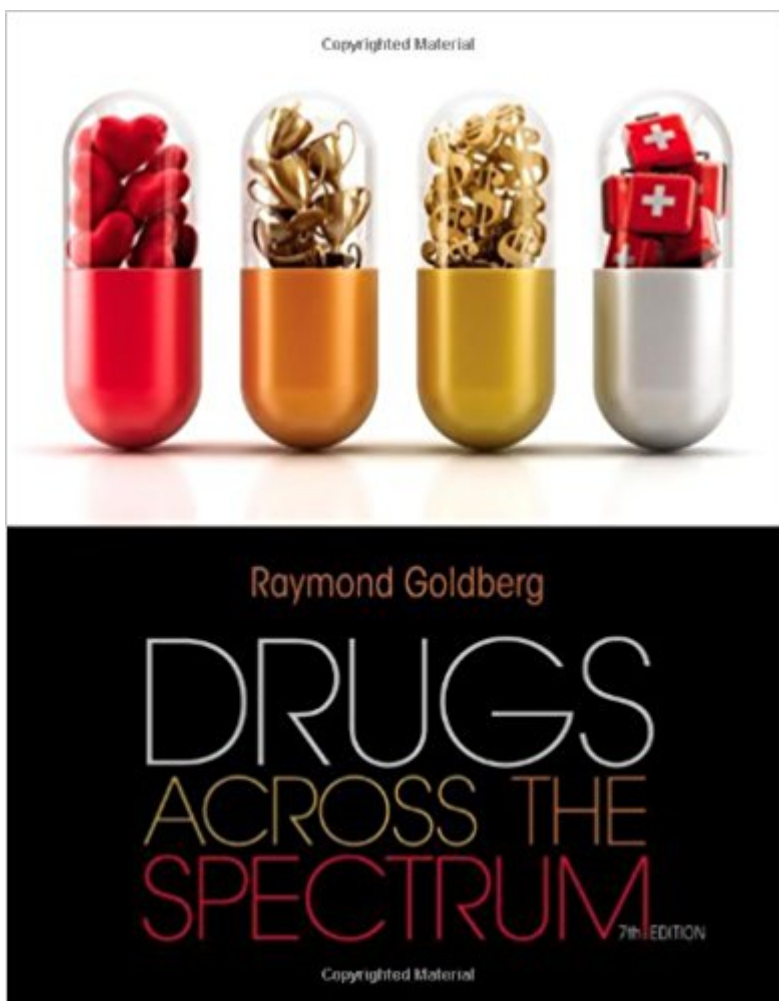

Raymond Goldberg is the Dean of Health Sciences at Vance-Granville Community College in North Carolina. Over the course of his career, Ray has taught a variety of drug-related courses, authored numerous articles on health- and drug-related topics and received several significant research grants for his work in health and drug education.

This book did more than talk about drugs. The author translated cold data and explained why someone would want to take this drug. He described a street view (and some photos) of the drug (color, how taken, amount people buy, various street names) and gave information on what the real effects and long term effects were on an individual. I found myself really getting carried away reading out of interest, not just the assigned amount. However, I think at times the book was a bit

odd. For example, the chapter on LSD (ch 13 Hallucinogens) described why so many artists particularly like the drug and even the military uses for it. It talks of studies but doesn't do a lot of citing these studies. So as a basic information it is fantastic. For a textbook to save for future research, this isn't one of them. (I believe the publisher has created quizzes to save the teacher some work, these answer keys are faulty. Hope the next edition fixes this issue).
