Stephen Brook first visited Prague in the mid-1980s, and it was one of the central European cities featured in his book The Double Eagle (1988). When he returned in 1991, the days of Communist rule were over and the city was enjoying a new lease on life, as reflected in his next book about the city, Prague (1992). Brook grew up in London, studied at Cambridge, and worked as a publisher's editor in the United States and in London before becoming a full-time writer in 1982. Since then he has written 30 books on a wide range of subjects, including travel, wine, opera, dreams, and infidelity. He has also contributed numerous articles to Vogue, The Times, the Cigar Aficionado, Cond $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\odot$ Nast Traveller, Decanter, and other publications.

I bought this book for my mother and grandmother who will be visiting us in Prague this summer. They both are avid readers and travelers. They could not say enough great things about this book. Although the city is small, there is so much to do and see here. So many things off the beaten path. This books allows you to understand each attraction and its history, so you can get an experience tailored to your wants and needs!
