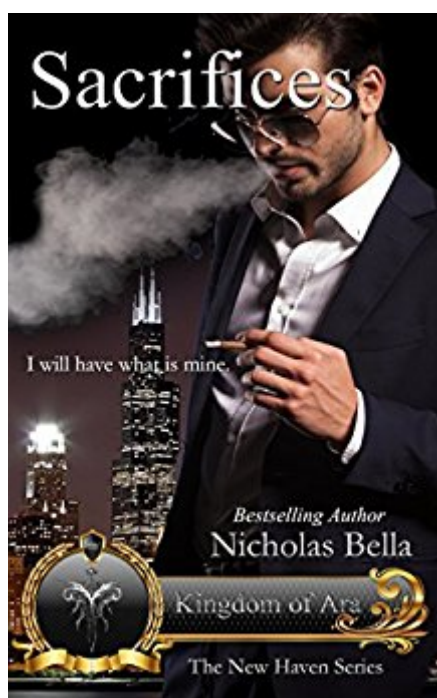

Wow, this is the end for New Haven; and what a journey. I remember when I first found this author and started this series. His premise was so different. He wanted to take a hero, a fighter for the people, and change him into the very thing he was striving to save humanity from. The monsters. Did he succeed in this grand finale? Hell yes. But the trip has been long and twisted (not to mention sexualicious) and not all threads have been answered. We now have more to look forward to in the *Odin Chronicles* with the continuation and building of both these and the introduction of further characters let's just say a new megalomaniac is on the horizon who will require that all the Supes of New Haven pull their proverbial socks up and work together *haha* good luck with that. Supes might not like humans but they also don't particularly get along with each other at least not interspecifically. But then there's nothing like a common enemy to weld people together. Am looking forward to seeing how this impending conflict will be resolved. So to *Sacrifices*, what did I think of it? Did I like it? As you can see from the star-rating it wasn't my usual five. So obviously, not as much. While I loved that Ryu was sent off with all the pomp and ceremony he deserved and that we got to hear from Michael and Tyler and even caught glimpses of that swine Jonah *disrespectful little git!* it only touched on some things I was really looking forward to, like Dante and Josef *cs* mating. Don't get me wrong, Dante's *humble-pie eating* (which was long overdue) was totally appreciated. Loved me some Elijah too, what a canny mate he turned out to be. And that Noel had finally embraced his full vampire nature was the ending that was demanded. But *There has always been a certain misogynistic tone to the New Haven series, that to this point I have ignored for many and varying reasons. I liked the characters; was caught in the story; accepted the token platitudes; had to know what was going to happen to my favourites and who would win out in the struggle for supremacy, and it can't be*

denied, a lot of it was sexy as all get out - I was invested in it but with Noel's total bisexual erasure in this episode it was actually a step too far for me. That and the sexual subjugation of straight men in which invariably the assumption is that they would find male intimacy far superior, they just didn't know it yet. I feel, however, that Nicholas Bella's books are written with integrity, the story must be told and the character's natures adhered to and that is his talent. He sticks to his guns. And I guess I must remember it's not just women that draw the short straw in New Haven, it is also ugly men. So, you might ask? Did I find this instalment worth it? Yes. The point of the story, despite everything else that has happened, was Noel's metamorphosis from envious man (Theoden's words) to self-privileged vampire he is that he is that monster now and loving every minute of it. It is now time to move forward in the world of New Haven and welcome in the trials and tribulations (and sexy shenanigans) of Odin County.

This is the final book for the New Haven series, but it's not the end of their tale but just a beginning. A while ago, I was deeply moved by the writing. Nicholas Bella not only writes a compelling story, but his books speak deeply to one's soul. It might not be pretty. His books were never pretty. They were dark and sensual and depraved, but these qualities are good for what it was. Erotica with a huge deep plot like these are rare. But if it's for you, you'll be addicted to it. Not one of the characters are one-dimensional but the book makes you work for it to see each of them in a different light. The world of Theoden is expanding and Noel's tale has just only begun. *Sacrifices* is the last of the New Haven series but fear not it is merely making way for the rest of its universe. The *Odin Chronicles* would certainly be well received I'm sure. This book is an emotional one for me. We get to see a more emotional side of a few characters. Well, as emotional as they could be (remember, his books were never sappy). You get to see characters change and grow into different persons. It is as though each book of the series you read in the past is a small investment and now it's harvest time :) I would foresee myself staying as a loyal fan for the rest of my life. I see myself loving characters I would never expect myself to love, hate characters that I usually don't care of and of course falling deeper in love with characters I've already adored. We get to see a small history of Theoden's past, it was a beautiful history that would certainly hold a place in my heart for the rest of my life. The series has yet to meet the limits of its destiny and in my heart I hope it never would. But for now, it's a certain call and I am standing with ovation. I will await patiently for the next show :)

This is the end of the New Haven series that has captivated most of us. We started with a human rebellion and the embracing of beautiful Noel, and we end with wolves being subjected to the sexual pleasure of both vampires and the dragons. The manipulation of events by Deacon has caused an unexpected takeover of Josef's territory by Theoden. Deacon remains in the dark over exactly what has happened... His war between dragon, vampires, and wolves didn't manifest as he hoped. There's so much unresolved with territory, alliances, manipulation, spying, and plots everywhere that it's difficult to see what's in store for everyone. Nicholas Bella has given us a great story with so many unanswered questions..... Cliffhangers doesn't begin to describe it. His imagination astounds me with every page of this 19 book series.... Each one as good as the previous ones. Now with so many questions he has us on the hook and we anxiously await further stories. Evil genius!

Each new book gets better than the last. This is the best series I've ever read and I'm looking forward to reading the "Odin Chronicles". As ever Theoden continued to prove why he is worthy to be Prince, his character never disappoints.
