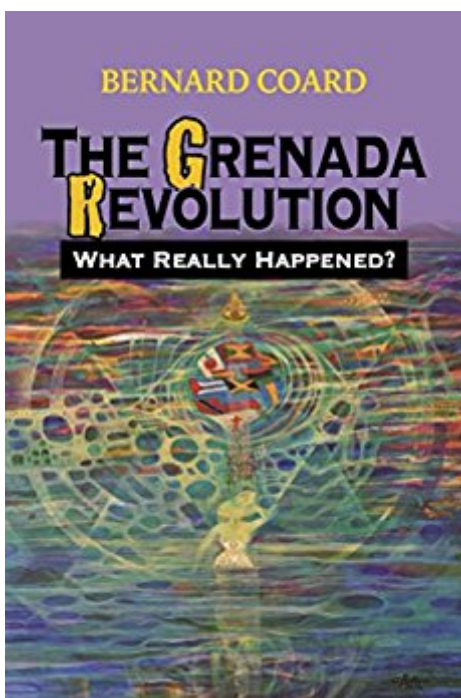

several times during and after the revolutionary period, who has studied and written about this extraordinary event in the Americas, a revolution led by mostly young black men and women, I found the book to be harshly honest and self-critical. For those with just a passing interest in the history of the US as an empire, to spy versus spy buffs, to those who seriously study revolution in search of better answers, this book is a "don't miss."
