

This story clearly took a lot of courage to write, and Newton is very humble and more than fair throughout. She doesn't waste any time on pointing fingers or portraying herself as perfect. I found it interesting to see how someone can hold complicated beliefs all at once...a sense of utter shame and worthlessness on the one hand, and a deep down belief that the abuse is wrong and there must be a way out on the other. However, I did find the story confusing at times. Such as whenever Newton talked about money. It sounded like she was given nothing by her ridiculously wealthy husband and left in poverty, to the point that she was living in a rat infested house, but later, she talks about moving out on her own and staying somewhere while she's having a house built. So, it's

unclear to me what her day to day finances were like, even though they're often mentioned in the book. Another confusing thing was the back and forth nature of her relationship with her husband. I am coming to understand that in abusive relationships, it's not horrendous every moment of every day - that there are enough dazzlingly wonderful or even reassuringly mundane moments to keep things off keel. But, I was hoping by reading this book I would understand what a woman is thinking as she's being pushed back and forth from apparently normal moments to horrendously abusive ones. I really didn't understand that any better after reading this. It's heartbreaking as an outsider to read of Newton's decisions to get married, have a child...to be tied tighter and tighter to her abuser, especially when the abuse became severe and there was no longer even a pretense of fidelity on her husband's part. And it was truly beautiful to reach the part of the story when she decided to leave. I don't want to sound like I'm downplaying the courage and inner fight that took for her. I just wanted to gain some understanding of that process from the woman's point of view, and by the end of this book I wasn't any closer to getting it. I do think, however, that it's an amazing story of resilience and willingness to forgive.

Dorothy Newton's autobiography is poignant. There are times when it's a bit slow, but she certainly conveys the gravity of domestic abuse. Her ex does not seem like a monster but a man with serious, human flaws which led to his abusive behavior. Only a good writer, such as Dorothy, could manage to describe his pain and hers in the same book.

This is very well written and a great way to help other women who are or have been in this type of environment. Dorothy did an outstanding job telling her story to encourage others to benefit knowing they are not alone. The finishing interview from Nate and each of their sons is awesome. Very recommended even for those who aren t in the situation but who may know someone who is. Thank you, Dorothy for your story given to others.
