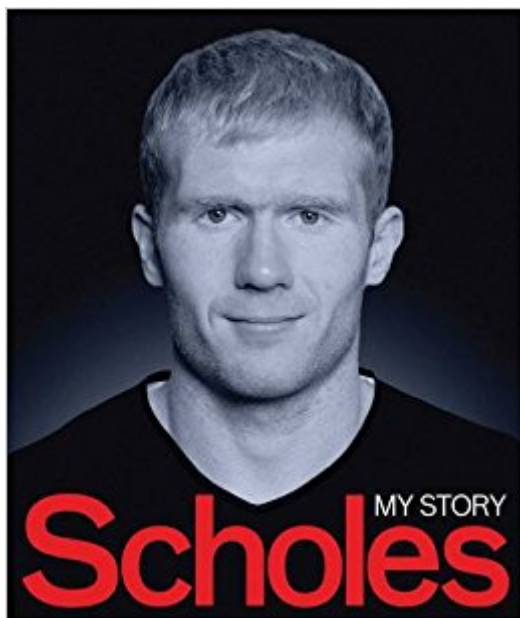

Scholes: My Story (MUFC)



Synopsis

Paul Scholes is one of the most revered footballers of the modern era, both at home and internationally. A one-club player, he has served Manchester United for more than sixteen years, making over 600 appearances in that time -- the fourth highest number of appearances by any player for the club. He also represented the England national team for seven years, winning 66 caps including two World Cup and two European Cup campaigns. Throughout this time, Scholes has always played a decisive role in his teams' fortunes. As well as the technical brilliance that makes Paul Scholes such a breathtaking player to watch it is the determination and integrity which he demonstrates both on and off the pitch that means he is a fascination to fans of the sport. In an age of overpaid, workaday players, Scholes has become an icon of professionalism and club loyalty, admired by fans everywhere. Now in this book for the first time Paul Scholes shares his story: from his beginnings at United under the tutelage of Sir Alex Ferguson as part of the 'golden' youth team, to the treble-winning season and twice capturing European Cup glory, the importance of family and friends in keeping his feet on the ground, as well as his many triumphs and tribulations with England. Paul Scholes has represented Manchester United for more than 16 years and represented the England national team from 1997 until his retirement in 2004. He was inducted into the Football

Hall of Fame in 2008.

Scholesy takes us through his wonderful career with Manchester United (sans 2012/13) with fantastic insight into key moments of his time at the club. The only disappointing thing about this book is that it's a little on the short side, I would've loved to get more details about certain moments that sometimes Scholes glances over however as any United fan would know it's typical of him to be straight forward and to the point. In the end I highly recommend this for Manchester United fans specifically and football fans in general.

Beautifully formatted and printed but really just a collection of photos with extended captions. I expected more insights but that's Paul Scholes for you. I suspect he didn't want to talk about himself so the publisher just presented him with a bunch of photos and asked him to write down what he remembered.

Solid interesting read about one of the modern legends of the game. Scholes seems like one of the good guys in life quiet, modest, unassuming but someone who had an extraordinary talent and used it to its fullest.

Very basic, simplistic, lazy attempt, which fails to offer any real insight into his career, or the major players who surrounded him. Good for children with short attention spans who desire chronological fact checks of his career with an abundance of pictures, though for those of us who would like a more in depth exploration of his career, a total let down. Read Gary Neville's book instead.

A great book by the Ginger maestro (and his ghost writer/photographer?). The pics are good - and it's hilarious. Like the man it doesn't get too serious about itself but at the same time gives good background on the player's personality and life as a Utd player.
