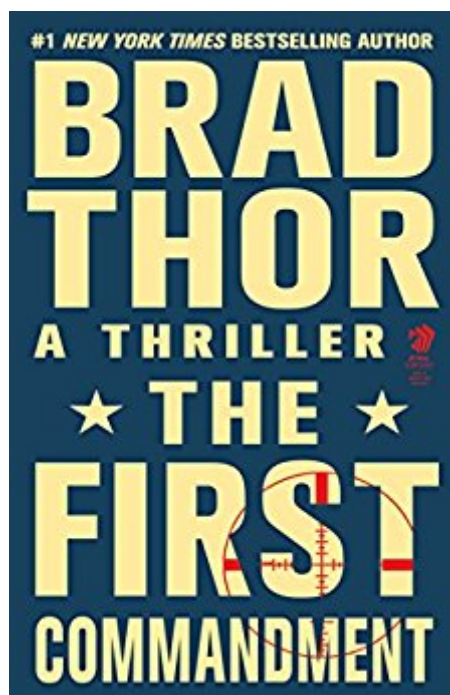

Evil is evil regardless of the ethnic background and having discovered that Hollywood sanitized some of Clancy's books to make it more politically correct, I like it when the author doesn't succumb to such tactics. In Thor's books, one knows who the evil ones are and you know that the protagonist will get them in the end. This book reminded me of a couple of seasons of the TV show 24, where the government turns on Jack and brands him a traitor when he is the only one seemingly capable of capturing/killing the terrorist. Unfortunately, this is a scenario I can too easily believe could happen in real life. Perhaps this is why it wasn't my favorite.
