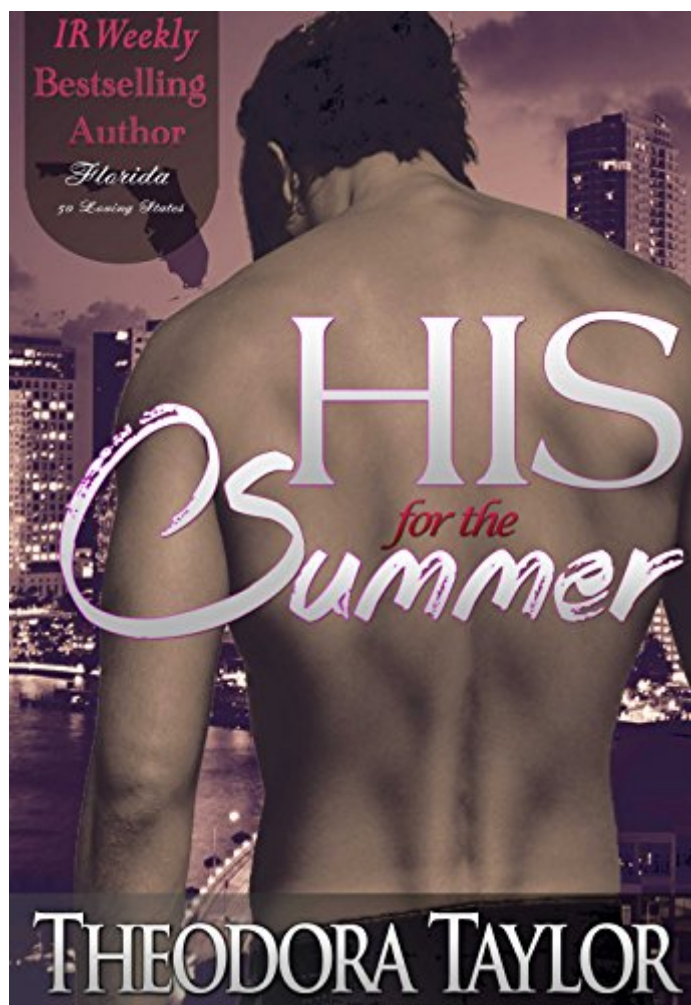

I don't know, but this story just didn't make it past 'foul ball' territory for me. When Ms. Taylor writes about Russians, she can knock 'em out of the park! However, when she writes past them, she appears to lose focus all around. In this story, I was happiest to read more about Alexei Rustanov than I was the main characters! All the story's important points were there: Gus' love for Cera, how they met, why Gus never strayed from his feelings, both family's development, etc. But, the blindfold routine? What??????? If this was just an experiment into something different for a theme, then I guess it's okay. I just hope we don't see more of it in future novels. Ms. Taylor, I love your style, and to your credit, you're an intense writer. You're also still one of my favorites. So, I'm looking forward to what you do best in your future writing. After all, we've got plenty of states to explore in your 50 Loving States series.

This could be one of my favorites, even my boys Suro and Alexei were in it! Gus and Cera were delicious together. The mystery, the history, the connection right from the start, all of it was sexy as hell. Am I in agreement with the way he went about things, absolutely not. Was it all worth it in the end, I'd say heck yeah. I loved Cera, her character was sweet and very deserving of every good thing she received. Deception plays a huge part in their lives but in the end Gus truly just wanted to make Cera his.

This story would have received a higher rating but had multiple grammatical and editing errors. Lacey Winters and daughter Sparkle live a life on the run but a one night stand with Tatsuro Nakamura, a Japanese business man, tosses a wrinkle into this plan. The relationship between the two autistic children, Kenji and Sparkles is achingly sweet and provides a small peek as to life with Asperger's is like. Despite the fact that ancillary characters are not fully developed, Theodora Taylor's books are enjoyable and I look forward to reading more of her stories with interwoven characters and adventures.

It's difficult to write why this book is my least favorite without giving away the main plot to the story. I'll just say that the way Gus did pretty much everything until revealing himself just set me off. The fact that she forgave him so easily, just pissed me off. If any man made me feel that way and betrayed me so completely, it would take a lot more than a single chat with a family member to fix everything.

His *For the Summer: 50 Loving States, Florida* is a very good and sensual interracial romance novel that earned a rating of four stars. I thoroughly enjoyed reading this book about a thirty year old African-American woman working hard to provide for her sister who has autism. A man from her past made her an offer she couldn't refuse that led her to fall in love with her mysterious benefactor. I would recommend this book to anyone who enjoys reading very good interracial romance novels.

This being part of the 50 states made it good. I did expect a little bit more since this was Gus's story and being in Florida. Gus had a lot to overcome from his past and Cera had to really grow up. Would have loved to read more about them connecting in other ways besides sex. It's nice to see the other characters pop in (love the twins). Looking forward to the next book.

I like this author, I really do, but I didn't exactly get this story. I didn't understand the need for the blindfolds and checks, all of it, it just seemed muddled and unclear as to why Gus needed to go through such machinations to be with Cera. It was explained, but for me it was a thin explanation. I also felt like this heroine was similar to many of her other heroines, selflessly taking care of a sibling or child, self-sacrificing, near angelic, and in this case virginal. I was hoping for more from this book, and all in all it wasn't bad, I just thought it could have been better.

Ok, this situation started out really weird. He pays her to be his for the summer. And she agrees. Smh. Definitely spoilers below. But the deep emotional stuff and their past makes it a more compelling story. He just went about it the wrong way. I understand that he had a rough childhood but how he didn't even consider how basically forcing her into a place where she had no choice but to take his money in exchange for sex would make her feel like a whore at some point is beyond me. I like how dedicated Cera is to her autistic sister. But I don't understand how she was ok with this situation. I don't get it. It just seems weird to me that she would accept his offer. Other than the strangeness of the situation and how controlling and obsessed Gus is, the book is very hot! Wow! Very smoking hot. But weird situation. And he really really really needed to learn that you can't buy

people like that. Not everyone is out for money. Sometimes you just need to be honest.
