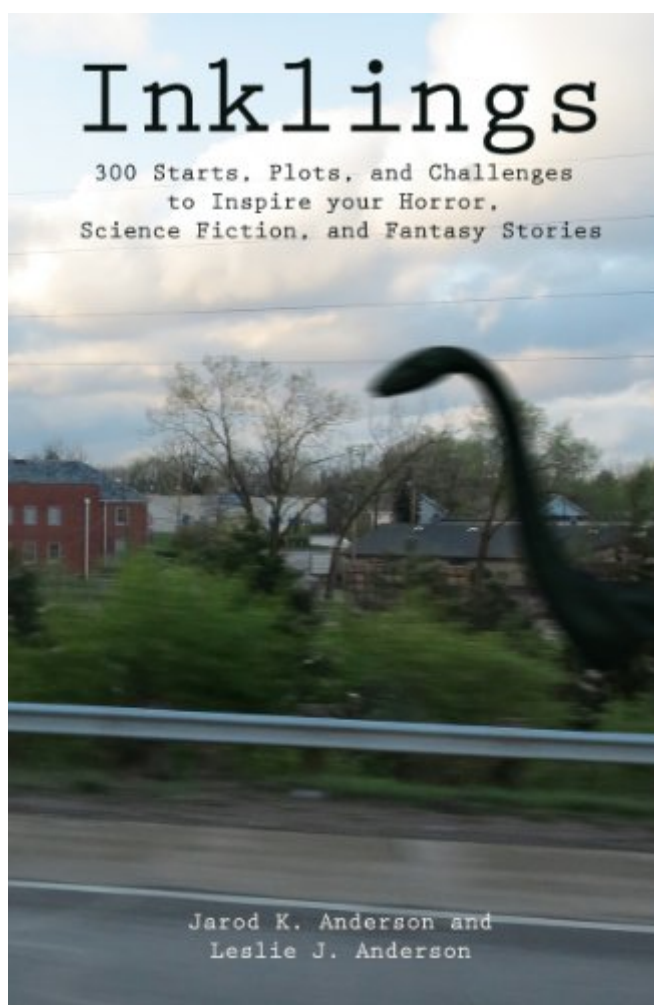

Not a how-to book on writing, just a lot of excellent "prompts" to help you jump-start ideas. Great stuff, and guaranteed to spark ideas -- what more could one ask for? One example: "Consider the walrus." Beautiful; just beautiful.

Most of the prompts in this book are really good. If I could change one thing, I'd reduce the number of prompts which are just previous prompts from a different angle, or slightly reworded.

Got it for my 13 year old daughter, and a few of the topics were a little mature for her. An age recommendation would be helpful. She really likes writing and has created a lot of stories with these ideas.

Just got 'Inklings' by Jarod Anderson and Leslie Anderson and had my first read-through. What a great help this is going to be! I found myself forming full story lines from their beginning sentences on every single page. Can't wait to see how those stories end! Buy this book!

It's a very basic, fairly thin book entirely of prompts. Some I found a little useless, but only because I don't lean toward whatever story might go along with them. It seems like it had some good prompts though and enough space in the margins to jot things down as I like to do, so it's really not beatable as far as price goes. Need some quick fodder for your writing muse, this is a good choice.

Even if you come away with only a handful of ideas, the inexpensive price was worth it. Remember, you can also combine the individual ideas, so that helps, too.

The book does have a few faults mostly repetition and I've found a few places that needed some more proofreading. But overall the book does what I bought it for. I needed something to give me story ideas simply for practice, which it does a great job of. Some of the writing prompts are very creative and even funny. It is a good buy and a fun little book.
