

Overall this conclusion was beautifully written and satisfying. It feels different than the first installment because even though it is centered on Shahrzad and Khalid $\tilde{A}f\tilde{A}\phi\tilde{A}$ \hat{a} $\neg\tilde{A}$ \hat{a} , ϕ s love it dwells more on the forces trying to tear them apart. This shifts caused the story to be more than just a romantic tale. There are many new perspectives in this installment including Irsa, Rahim, and Omar.
