

Berryman is a consultant in the areas of religious education, child development, and spiritual direction for children. He is the author of Godly Play: An Imaginative Approach to Religious Education.

If you are seeking a broad ranging, Christ centered curriculum, look no further! This is a wonderful program created for children between the ages of 3 to 7. Using a calming, quiet, questioning format allows the children to formulate and ask questions meaningful to their faith-walk. However, there is much prepatory work in this curriculum - you must either create paper (laminate for future use!) or wooden figures to work with, fabrics and props to create the scenes and plastic shoe boxes to store all this in - for the children enjoy working with stories long after they are told. Be prepared to spend some time (and volunteers!) to help put these kits together. Overall, it's allowed even our most

wiggly ADD children to connect on a deeper level with their Lord and saviour. And that's why I teach Sunday School - thank you for creating something that works!

I love that this book encourages children to explore scripture spiritually. The language, rituals, and silence of worship are so important. It is challenging to change from tradition Sunday School with arts and crafts to this form of children's worship. Our teachers find the silence challenging and do not like the basic reflection time. I, however, love it and think it works well. The biggest challenge for me is building all the supplies needed to tell the stories. They are very expensive to buy and we do not have someone to make them.

This curriculum opens God's sacred stories to children in a way that offers time to wonder and respond to them out of their own experience. It is complete with guides to setting up a center and patterns for creating story figures. Training is recommended.
