

Chase Sargent is a decorated fire officer who spent more than 26 years with the City of Virginia Beach Fire and Rescue Department as a Firefighter/Paramedic, Lieutenant, Captain, Battalion Chief, and recently retired as a Division Chief in command of B-shift. He obtained his BS degree in Forestry and Wildlife, with a major in Fisheries Biology from Virginia Tech and his MPA from Golden Gate University. He completed the Executive Fire Officer program and is an NFA instructor. Chase is a member of VATF-2 and the Operations Chief for FEMA's Urban Search and Rescue White Incident Support Team. Chase was the night operations officer at both the Oklahoma City Bombing and the World Trade Center Collapse. He is the president of Spec Rescue International, a training and consulting company in Virginia Beach. Chase has been the Chief Tactical Paramedic for the Norfolk division of the FBI since 1995 and is both COTOMS and OEMS qualified. Currently, he works as an independent contractor to the US Government (DOS/DSS) and volunteers as a firefighter in Virginia Beach and as a paramedic for the Courthouse Volunteer Rescue Squad.

While I'm sure the author is a great leader, he should not have written a book or at least had someone do it for him. I agree with him 100% but this book is very repetitive and goes in the same circle over and over. I had to get this for a promotion exam in the fire dept. and feel that it could be a good book if it were cut in half ,but 400 pages of the same point reworded takes a toll on the human mind. He should have put trust in the reader that his message was received the third time around before reaching ch 4. This book has good points, but needs to be put in a logical and applicable

order. On the next edition , please proof read as I'm sure there will be a 2nd edition , which inevitably is what these writers do to keep making money off of those that have to purchase these books.

I am dissapointed with the organization and format of the CDs themself. I am only on disk 6 right now and already 1 disk is labelled wrong or the narrator called it the wrong disk and the beginning of one of the chapters is cut off. I agree with the person that complained about it being 17 disks. Certainly, they could have used a different format that would have been more user friendly. As far as putting it on a phone or mp3, it's a bit of work to get them transferred and I'm still working on it. The disks do play well in the car. The narrator has a great reading voice, except for a couple mispronunciations of technical terms. You get the gist of the material, but I would recommed buying the book on this one and getting a different audio book. I'm going to leave the material itself alone. I'm reading (or rather listening) to this for a promotional process so my oppinion on the that part of it doesn't matter.

This book is terrible. The author rambles and contradicts himself throughout the book. It Cleary did not have an editor that read it through. Not to mention that it has a very negative tone toward his former dept and other government agencies. Just a complete waste of time.

Seriously, 17 disks? File information isn't even the same from disk to disk so that when you put them into iTunes they end up in the same place. I'm not an iTunes guru, and maybe someone could explain it to me, but 17 disks is an inconvenient way to use this material.

I'd give it zero if I could. Repetitive and repulsive. Author talks about how great he is 1/3 of the time and the rest of the time contradicts himself.
