

Read through the book and was dissatisfied. Really all of its contents are mostly common sense ideas and I would say it is more effective to just research online the specific school that you are interviewing at and general questions. I had interviewed at three different schools and all three asked the most common/general questions that you would expect therefore having a great delivery I thought was the most important aspect.

I read this book twice and did great at my interview. Unfortunately I was not chosen for the program but this book is a must if you are in the process of apply. Read it thoroughly and take notes. Very helpful and preps u well.

It all seems like common sense. This book put me more at ease with the interview process. There are a lot of questions that he helps you answer, but it must be said that they aren't ALL in there. You will get thrown a curve ball in the interview so don't rehearse your answers. The book is that will help you structure your answers and avoid pitfalls.

Really helped me ace my interviews!Was accepted to all three programs I applied to. Be sure though to study possible derivations of the questions and be prepared for this question: "I know you probably prepared for this interview. Tell us one question you prepared for. Give us your answer." I think it was also helpful in preparing for the group sections but not any interview sections involving writing. It does tell you to dress in a dark suit but actually all three schools commented to the group with, "Wow, looks like they were having a sale on dark suit jackets." I wore a royal blue dress with black jacket and that made me stand out in a good way.

I read this book before my interview & even omw on the greyhound bus. It helped me in the sense to have sense of questions that will be asked, prepared simple answers about straightforward questions, and the key thing I learned was to always answer questions based on an experience you had rather than just answering point blank. After I read the book, my interview was extremely successful. Accepted in 2015.

This was very helpful in preparing me for my school interviews. I felt that I would have not done so

well without it. Matter a fact after my interviews I was contacted within two days to state that I had been accepted to the program. I was invited to three schools, interviewed at two accepted to both, and declined my third interview. I also used Getting into physician assistant school.

This book is actually pretty helpful in preparing you for interviews and how best to "market" yourself to admission boards. With some schools going to the "multiple mini interviews" where you enter a room and have 8 minutes to discuss a topic or complete a task it isn't very helpful. But for those still doing the traditional or group interviews it's a great starting point.

This helped my daughter to be more prepared for her second Physician's Assistant School interview. Wish I had of found it before her first one (costly mistake), live and learn! She loved it and thought it was so helpful and informative. She especially liked how it helped her prepare for the scenario based questions, that she wasn't prepared for in her first interview.
